EASTER PROGRAM

We hope that you will plan to join us in the Fellowship Hall on Easter Sunday morning for a time of fellowship and celebration of Holy Week and Easter. The program will allow us to travel the steps that Jesus took during His last week on earth. There will be many elements to our observation including music, scripture readings, the sacrament of the Lord's Supper. The children will lead us on this walk to the Triumphal Entry, the Last Supper, the Garden of Gethsemane, the Crucifixion, and the Resurrection. The Christian Education Ministry will serve a Breakfast Biscuit Bar which will start at **9:45**. The program will begin at **10:00**.

HOLY WEEK

Holy Week is the last week in Lent, beginning with Palm Sunday, April 14th and going through Saturday, April 20th (Holy Saturday). It is given special attention because of its significance as we remember the suffering of Christ. On **Palm Sunday**, we will remember the triumphal entry of Jesus into Jerusalem that was characterized by the crowds waving palm branches and proclaiming Jesus as the Messiah (John 12:13). Our worship will begin with our children waving palm branches as they walk down the aisle of the sanctuary during the prelude. **Maundy Thursday, April 18** is the anniversary of the institution of the Lord's Supper, which was held the evening before the crucifixion. The name *Maundy Thursday* is taken from the Latin *mandatum*, meaning "command", referring to the "new commandment" Jesus gave us to love one another as He loved us. We will observe this special moment in the life of Christ with a worship service beginning at 7:00 o'clock that evening.

EASTER SUNDAY, APRIL 21

Easter Sunday is the most important day of the church year! "Christ is risen! Alleluia!" The resurrection is the keystone of Christianity. Without it, everything else crumbles. We Christians moved our day of worship from the last day of the week to the first so that each Sunday is a "little Easter." Easter is the oldest festival of the church year. The 50 days of Easter is older than either Lent or Advent. The emphasis moves from the penitential tone of our lost condition during Lent to the promised land of the redemption of God and Easter triumph. The color for the Easter Season is white.

IT'S EASTER LILY TIME!

This Easter we will again be building the Cross of Lilies. Lilies may be bought in honor or in memory of a loved one. The cost is \$10.00 per plant and includes a plastic sleeve around the pot.
